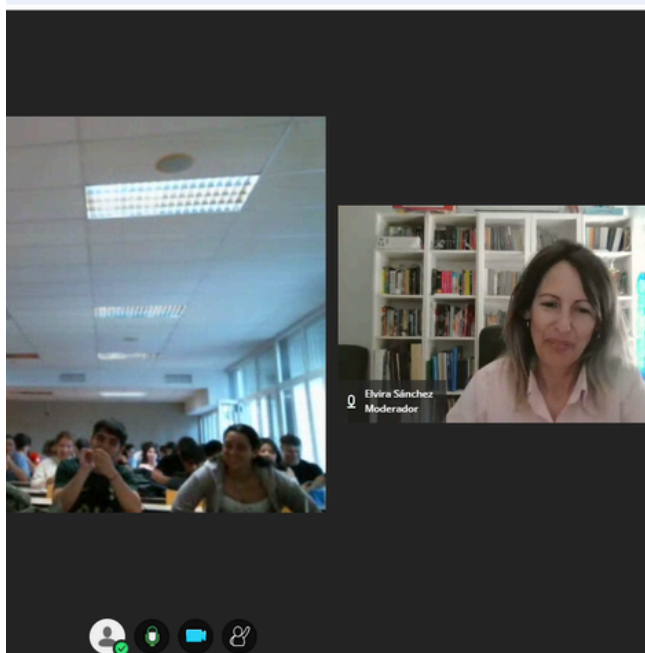




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# PROMOTING SCHOOL LEADERSHIP IN EUROPE: DISCOVER THE RESULTS OF THE S4S PROJECT



After 30 months of intense international cooperation, the Erasmus+ project S4S – The School for the Schools is drawing to a close, leaving behind a concrete and innovative legacy for educational leadership training in secondary schools.

Involving 9 partners from 7 countries (Italy, Spain, Romania, Poland, Greece, Bulgaria, and Sweden), S4S promoted an inclusive and digital approach, based on peer collaboration, to strengthen teachers' leadership skills in an ever-evolving school environment.

## Project Results

S4S has delivered four key outputs, all available in eight languages:

- ✓ A European Competence Matrix for Educational Leadership (WP2)
- ✓ A blended, multilingual training course for teachers (WP3)
- ✓ The LET Platform – Leadership Education for Teachers (WP4), a free and accessible digital learning environment
- ✓ An Online Collection of Good Practices (WP5), a validated repository of effective school leadership practices.

## 14 Events, One Shared Vision: Schools Inspiring Schools

To ensure the effective dissemination and real-world application of its results, S4S organised 14 multiplier events – two in each partner country – involving teachers, school leaders, trainers, and stakeholders at both local and international levels.

Each event featured:

- Interactive presentations of the project's Work Packages
- Live demonstrations of the LET platform
- Sharing of good practices and teacher experiences
- Moments of evaluation and networking

📍 Italy – San Miniato (9 April 2025) and online (28 April 2025): organised by ITC Cattaneo and FORIUM, with 100 total participants

📍 Romania – Pitești (21 March 2025): 45 participants on site and 47 online, with Universitatea din Pitești and Colegiul MT

📍 Spain – Mijas (9 April 2025): 44 on-site and 30 online participants, with Innovation Training Center

📍 Poland – Rzeszów (16 and 26 April 2025): 40 participants on-site and 36 online, with Danmar Computers and ZSEiU

📍 Greece – Mytilene (9 April 2025): 44 participants on-site and 30 online, hosted by the Model School of the University of the Aegean

📍 Bulgaria – Sofia (24 April 2025): two events with 98 participants, hosted by 32 SU "St. Kliment Ohridski"

📍 Sweden – Uppsala (11 March 2025): 54 on-site and 20 online participants, with Folkuniversitetet during the Erasmus Day



In total, over 590 teachers and stakeholders took part in the events, contributing to the dissemination and validation of S4S resources.

#### Focus: Multiplier Event Content

Each event followed a shared and interactive structure, which included:

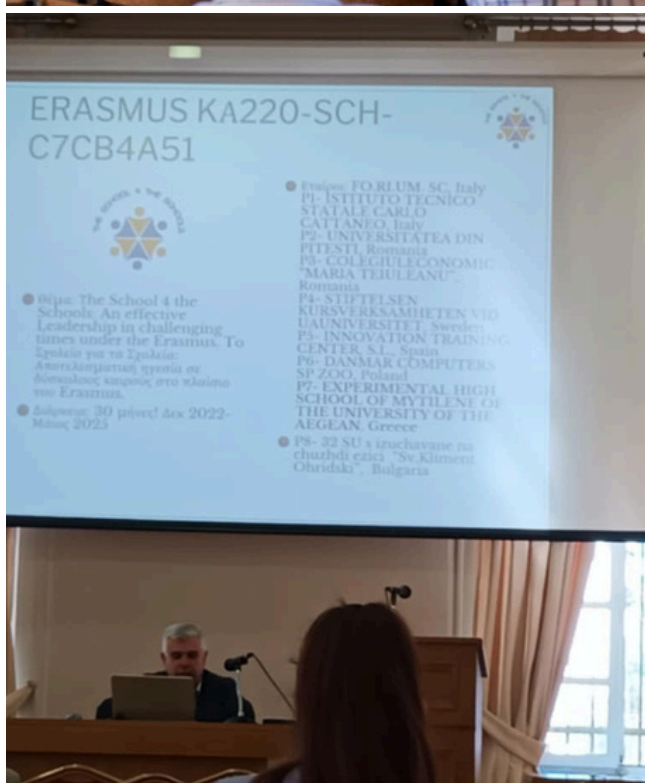
- Welcome & Opening – Institutional greetings
- Presentation of the Work Packages – Goals, activities, and outcomes
- LET Platform Demo – Guided exploration of the online learning space
- Sharing of Good Practices – Teachers' real-life leadership experiences
- Evaluation & Closing Remarks – Final questionnaire and guidance on using the resources
