The new blended course for teacher leadership training: innovation in post-pandemic education

The S4S project, now in its third phase, has introduced a blended course (a mix of online training with interactive webinars replacing traditional face-to-face sessions and distance learning) aimed at high school teachers, with the goal of redefining post-pandemic education from a leadership perspective.

The main objective was to equip educators with the skills necessary to lead the transition from remote to inperson learning, in line with the evolving educational needs. Structured in modules, each with specific learning objectives, the course offered a comprehensive framework that included

theoretical foundations, practical exercises, reflective practices, and continuous leadership development opportunities.
