Promoting School Leadership in Europe: Discover the Results of the S4S Project

The Erasmus+ project **S4S – The School for the Schools** is nearing its conclusion after **30 months of international cooperation** among **9 partners from 7 countries** (Italy, Spain, Romania, Poland, Greece, Bulgaria, and Sweden). The project focused on strengthening **educational leadership in secondary schools**, promoting **inclusive teaching, digital innovation, and peer collaboration** through **multilingual and accessible training tools**.

S4S has delivered **four main results**:

- **A European Competence Matrix for Educational Leadership** (WP2)
- **A blended, multilingual training course** for teachers (WP3)
- **The LET Platform (Leadership Education for Teachers)**, a free online learning space available in 8 languages (WP4)
- **An Online Collection of Good Practices**, a set of leadership practices shared and validated by teachers (WP5)

14 Events, One Shared Vision: Schools Inspiring Schools

To ensure broad dissemination and concrete applicability of its results, the project organised **14 multiplier events** (two in each partner country), combining **local engagement** with **international visibility**. Each event featured **live demonstrations of the LET platform**, **testimonies from teachers** involved in the pilot phase, **interactive activities**, and **reflections** on how to integrate leadership into school development processes.

📍 In **Italy**, the events were held on **9 April 2025** in San Miniato (77 participants) and **28 April 2025** online (23 participants), organised by ITC Cattaneo and FORIUM.

📍 In **Romania**, the events took place in **Pitești** on **21 March 2025**, involving Universitatea din Pitești and Colegiul MT, with teachers and university students from across the Argeș region (45 participants on-

site, 47 online).

📍 In **Spain**, the events were held in **Mijas** on **9 April 2025**, in collaboration with Innovation Training Center and local secondary schools (44 participants on-site, 30 online).

📍 In **Poland**, the events were hosted in **Rzeszów** on **16 April 2025** by Danmar Computers and the partner school ZSEiU, engaging local education stakeholders. An additional online event was held on **26 April** (40 participants on-site, 36 online).

📍 In **Greece**, the events were organised in **Mytilene** at the Model High School of the University of the Aegean on **9 April 2025** (44 participants on-site, 30 online).

📍 In **Bulgaria**, **32 SU "St. Kliment Ohridski"** in Sofia hosted two highly attended events on **24 April 2025**, presenting the LET platform as a national model for leadership training (98 participants).

📍 In **Sweden**, **Folkuniversitetet** involved national trainers and adult education professionals, showcasing the results also during an **Erasmus Day** on **11 March 2025** (54 participants on-site, 20 online).

In total, **over 590 teachers and stakeholders** took part in the multiplier events.

Following the institutional welcome, the partners presented the project's main

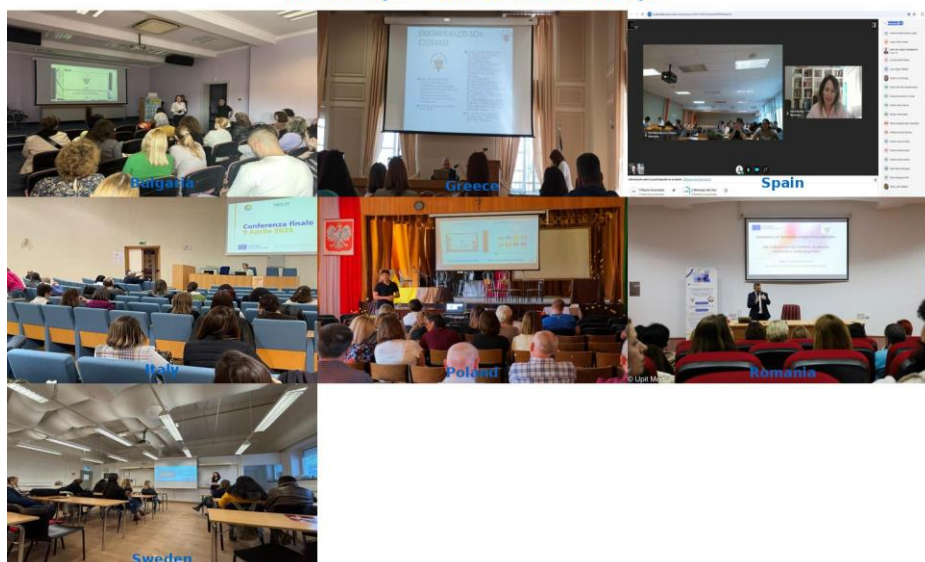
Work Packages, outlining their **objectives, results, and impact**.
